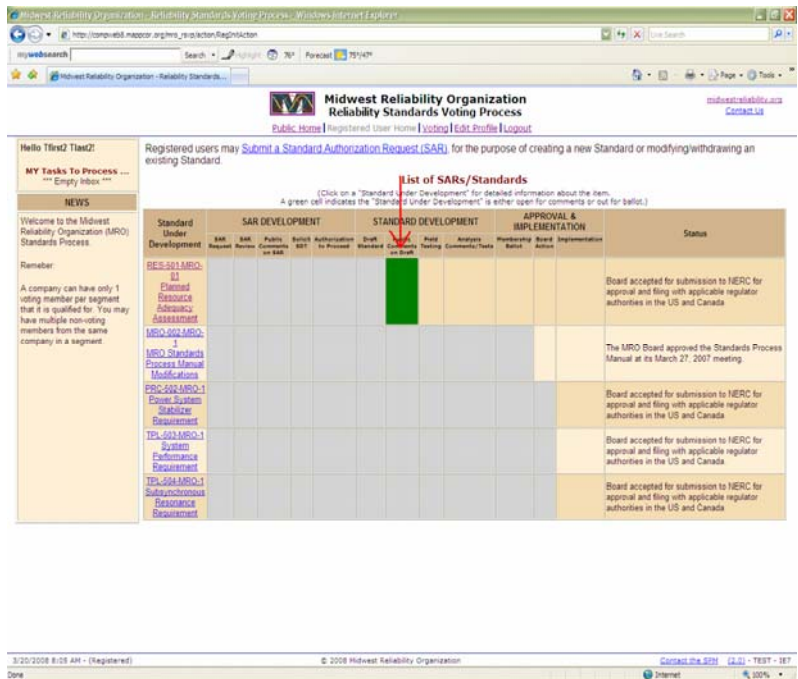
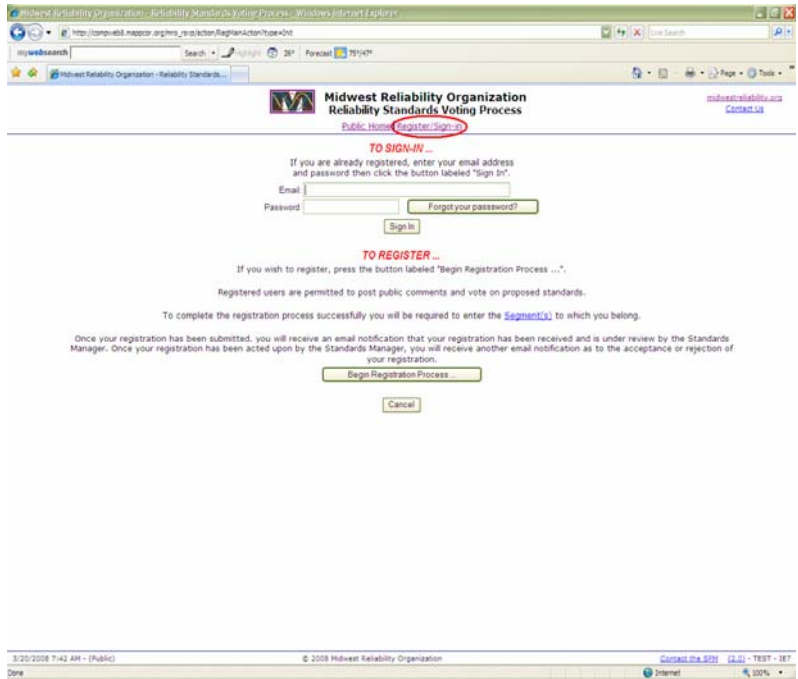


# How to Post a Comment

Click on the standard you would like to leave a comment on.

Click on "Post a Comment" under the "Public Comments" column.

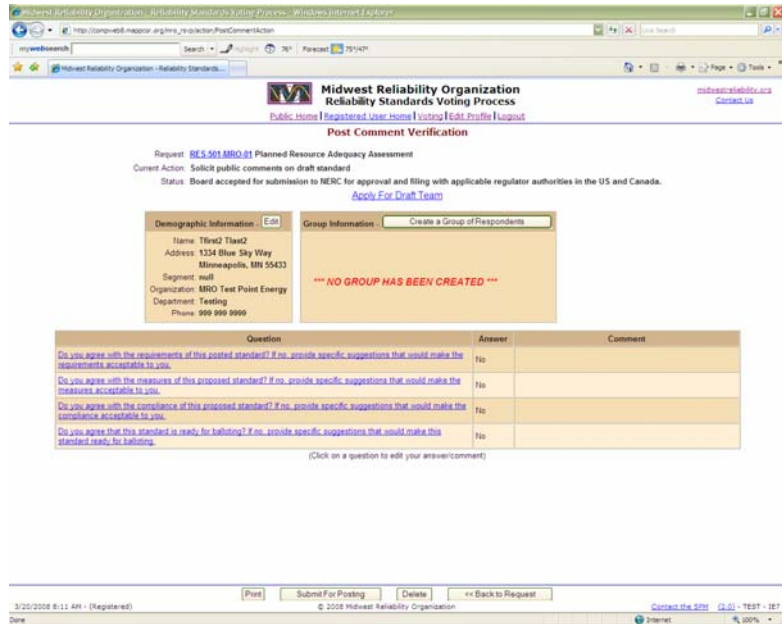

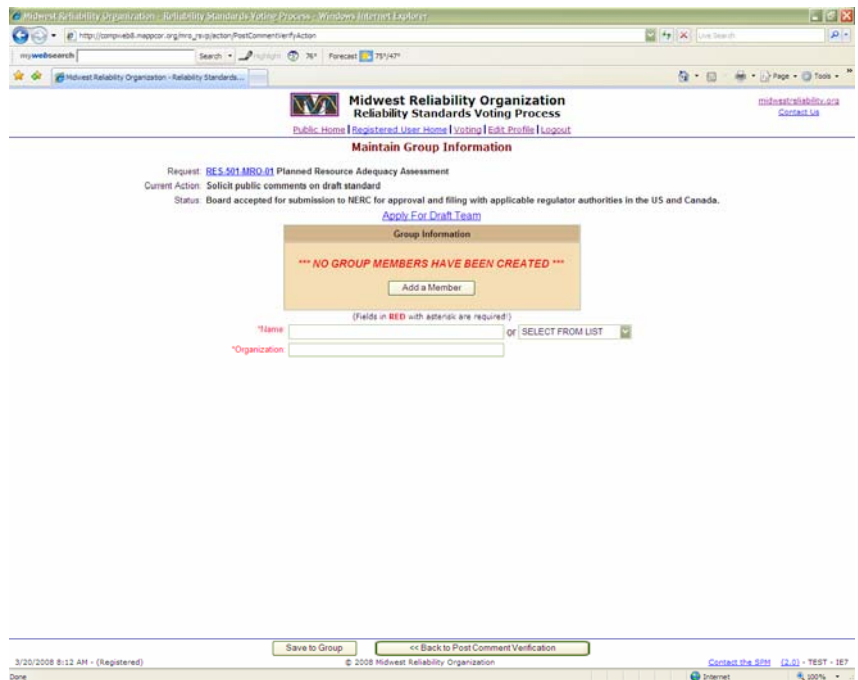
