Frequently Asked Transition Questions Now Available

SAINT PAUL. In early March, MRO staff began reaching out to the compliance contacts of each of the 109 SPP RE registered entities that will soon be registered in MRO, contingent upon FERC approval of the revised delegation agreement expanding MRO's boundaries. The purpose of this initial contact was to introduce our staff and respond to any questions or concerns regarding the transition.
