Providing the correct information in a Self-Report (or Self-Log) allows MRO to understand the circumstances, cause and duration of a potential noncompliance, which in turn ensures an efficient and timely resolution.

This webinar will focus on the framework for the scope and content to be included in an entity's self-report that will expedite processing of self-identified noncompliance.
